1. Be ready in halt at A. Wait for judge to nod before proceeding in walk to B
2. At B trot a circle around C and back to B
3. At B walk. Walk to D

4. At D, trot half circle to A around E
 5. At A, turn and walk to B.
 6. At B, halt on loose rein 10 seconds. Proceed in walk to D
 7. At D halt. Nod to judge.
- End of pattern

1. Be ready in halt at A. Wait for judge to nod before proceeding in walk for 3 strides then trot to B
2. At B trot a circle around C and back to B
3. At B direct transition to halt 10 seconds on loose rein. Walk to D
4. At D, direct transition to canter, canter half circle around E towards A
5. Before A, walk. At A halt, turn on haunches 90° and walk to B.
6. At B halt. Back up 6 strides. Halt Nod to judge.
End of pattern

Show rules

Please read and follow the rules below to make sure that everyone enjoys the show and that all goes as smoothly as possible.

1. Stallions and colts must be handled by person over 18 years of age, display a blue tail ribbon and stallion discs on both sides of bridle.
2. Hard hats to the current BHS recommended standard to be worn at all times whilst mounted.
3. Where possible, please do not leave horses unattended. If you do not have anyone with you, please inform the secretary to arrange a horse-sitter!
4. Please ensure that you clear up after your horse. Please remember to bring a poop scoop and use the brown bins provided around the arena to deposit said poop.
5. Please be polite to everyone. If you have a problem, see the secretary, don't start a row.
6. Judges decision is final. Please respect it.
7. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and may not be taken onto the veranda.
8. There are other competitions/camps going on at the venue so please park in the designated area.
9. Please only warm up in the warm up area provided.
10. Abuse of the horses in any form will not be tolerated.
