**Class 1** **M&M RIDDEN SPORTS PONY** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh Sections A, B, C & D. Rider any age. To be judged on capability as a Sports / Dressage Pony.

This show is a qualifier for the **BSPS WOW FACTOR**. Ponies placed 1<sup>st</sup> in the Open/Restricted Heritage classes will qualify for the WOW FACTOR at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

**Class 2** **BSPS OPEN / RESTRICTED RIDDEN NEW FOREST / CONNEMARA** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Connemara or New Forest. Rider any age.

**Class 3** **BSPS OPEN / RESTRICTED RIDDEN DALES / FELL / HIGHLAND** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Dales, Fell or Highland. Rider any age.

**Class 4** **BSPS OPEN / RESTRICTED RIDDEN WELSH C & D** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Welsh Sections C & D. Rider any age.

**BSPS LARGE BREEDS CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 1-4 to compete.

**Class 5** **BSPS OPEN / RESTRICTED RIDDEN WELSH A & B** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Welsh Sections A & B. Rider any age.

**Class 6** **BSPS OPEN / RESTRICTED RIDDEN M&M SMALL BREEDS** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland. Rider any age.

**BSPS SMALL BREEDS CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 5-6 to compete.

**Class 7** **RESTRICTED M&M LARGE BREEDS** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Sections C & D. rider any age. Pony & Rider NOT to have qualified for RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in 2018.

**Class 8** **RESTRICTED M&M SMALL BREEDS** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B. rider any age. Pony & Rider NOT to have qualified for RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in 2018.

**RESTRICTED M&M CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 7-8 to compete.

**Class 9** **NOVICE RIDERS M&M** – mare or gelding 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh Sections A, B, C & D. Rider any age. Rider not to have won a first prize in any affiliated showing class since 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 10** **AMATEUR RIDER M&M LARGE BREEDS** – stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland & New Forest. Rider any age. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**Class 11** **AMATEUR RIDER WELSH C & D** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the pure bred stud books of Welsh Sections C & D. Rider any age. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**AMATEUR M&M CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 10-11 to compete.

Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**Class 13** **AMATEUR WELSH SECTIONS A & B** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered in the pure bred stud books of Welsh Sections A & B. Rider any age. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**AMATEUR M&M CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 12-13 to compete.

**Class 14** **RESTRICTED M&M LEAD REIN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered in the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B, not to exceed 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Snaffle bridle only, the lead rein to be attached to the nose band. Pony and rider **NOT** to have qualified for RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in 2018.

**Class 15** **OPEN M&M LEAD REIN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered in the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B, not to exceed 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Snaffle bridle only, the lead rein to be attached to the nose band.

**Class 16** **RESTRICTED M&M FIRST RIDDEN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered in the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B, not to exceed 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Any suitable bridle. Pony and rider **NOT** to have qualified for RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in 2018.

**Class 17** **OPEN M&M FIRST RIDDEN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered in the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B, not to exceed 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Any suitable bridle.

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 14-17 to compete.

**Class 18** **TINY TOTS M&M LEAD REIN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over registered in the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B, not to exceed 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Snaffle bridle only. The lead rein to be attached to the noseband.

**Class 19** **M&M COLT / FILLY FOAL** – colt or filly foal born in 2018. Registered or eligible for registration with any of the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A, B, C, & D.

**Class 20** **OPEN COLT / FILLY FOAL** – colt or filly foal born in 2018. Any breed / any height.

**FOAL CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 19-20 to compete.

**Class 21** **WELSH A, B, C, D 1,2,3 YEARS OLD** – colt, filly or gelding, registered in the pure bred stud books of Welsh Sections A, B, C & D. To be shown in hand.

**Class 22** **M&M NON-WELSH 1,2,3 YEARS OLD** – colt, filly or gelding, registered in the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest & Shetland. To be shown in hand.

**Class 23** **M&M SMALL BREEDS 4 YEARS & OVER** – stallion, mare or gelding, registered in the pure bred stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B. To be shown in hand.

**Class 24** **M&M LARGE BREEDS 4 YEARS & OVER** – stallion, mare or gelding, registered in the pure bred stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Sections C & D. To be shown in hand.

**Class 25 RIDDEN VETERANS 15-19 YEARS** – stallion, mare or gelding, any height or type. Rider any age.

**Class 26 RIDDEN VETERANS 20 YEARS & OVER** – stallion, mare or gelding, any height or type. Rider any age.

**VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 25-26 to compete.

**Class 27 AMATEUR RIDER PIEBALD/SKEWBALD** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height or type. Rider any age. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**Class 28 JUNIOR RIDER PIEBALD/SKEWBALD** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any size or type. Rider not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 29 LEAD REIN/FIRST RIDDEN PIEBALD/SKEWBALD** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Any type. Rider not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 30 OPEN RIDDEN PIEBALD/SKEWBALD** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Any size or type. Rider any age.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 27-30 to compete.

**Class 31 NOVICE RIDDEN PIEBALD/SKEWBALD** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Not to have won a first prize in any showing class before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Rider any age.

**Class 32 RESTRICTED RIDDEN PIEBALD/SKEWBALD** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any size or type. Horse / Pony and rider **NOT** to have qualified for RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in 2018.

**Class 33 NOVICE RIDERS 9 YEARS & UNDER** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over to ride a pony of a suitable size. Snaffle bridles only. Walk & trot only, but riders may canter in individual shows if they wish. Riders to be in their first season of showing off of the leading rein.

**Class 34 NOVICE RIDERS 10-16 YEARS OLD** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over to ride a pony of a suitable size. Snaffle bridles only. Walk & trot only, but riders may canter in individual shows if they wish. Riders to be in their first season of showing.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 31-34 to compete.

## INDOOR RING TWO – SUNDAY 16<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER

### **BSPS WINTER QUALIFICATIONS:**

In the Open (Restricted) Classes the qualification will be awarded to the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class, and in the mixed height Open (Restricted) classes the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders of Restricted animals MUST wear an armband). Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

The 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Prize winners in the Open (Restricted) classes will qualify for the BSPS Premier League at the BSPS Summer Championships.

**Class 35 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHP 133CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders must be correct age for the height of pony they ride.

**Class 36 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHP 153CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 153cs. Riders must be correct age for the height of pony they ride.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 35-36 to compete.

**Class 37 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW PONY 148CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be correct age for the height of pony they ride.

**Class 38 BSPS OPEN SHT 158CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 39 BSPS OPEN SRT 158CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 38-39 to compete.

**Class 40 RIDDEN 3 YEARS OLD PONY 148CMS** – stallion, mare or gelding born in 2015, not exceeding 148cms. Rider any age. Walk and trot only.

**Class 41 RIDDEN 3 YEARS OLD HORSE EXCEEDING 148CMS** – stallion, mare or gelding born in 2015, exceeding 148cms. Rider any age. Walk and trot only.

**Class 42 RESTRICTED RIDDEN COB** – mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Rider any age. Horse and rider **NOT** to have qualified for RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in 2018.

**Class 43 AMATEUR RIDDEN PLAITED PONY** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 148cms. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**Class 44 AMATEUR RIDDEN PLAITED HORSE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**Class 45 AMATEUR RIDDEN HOGGED COB** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

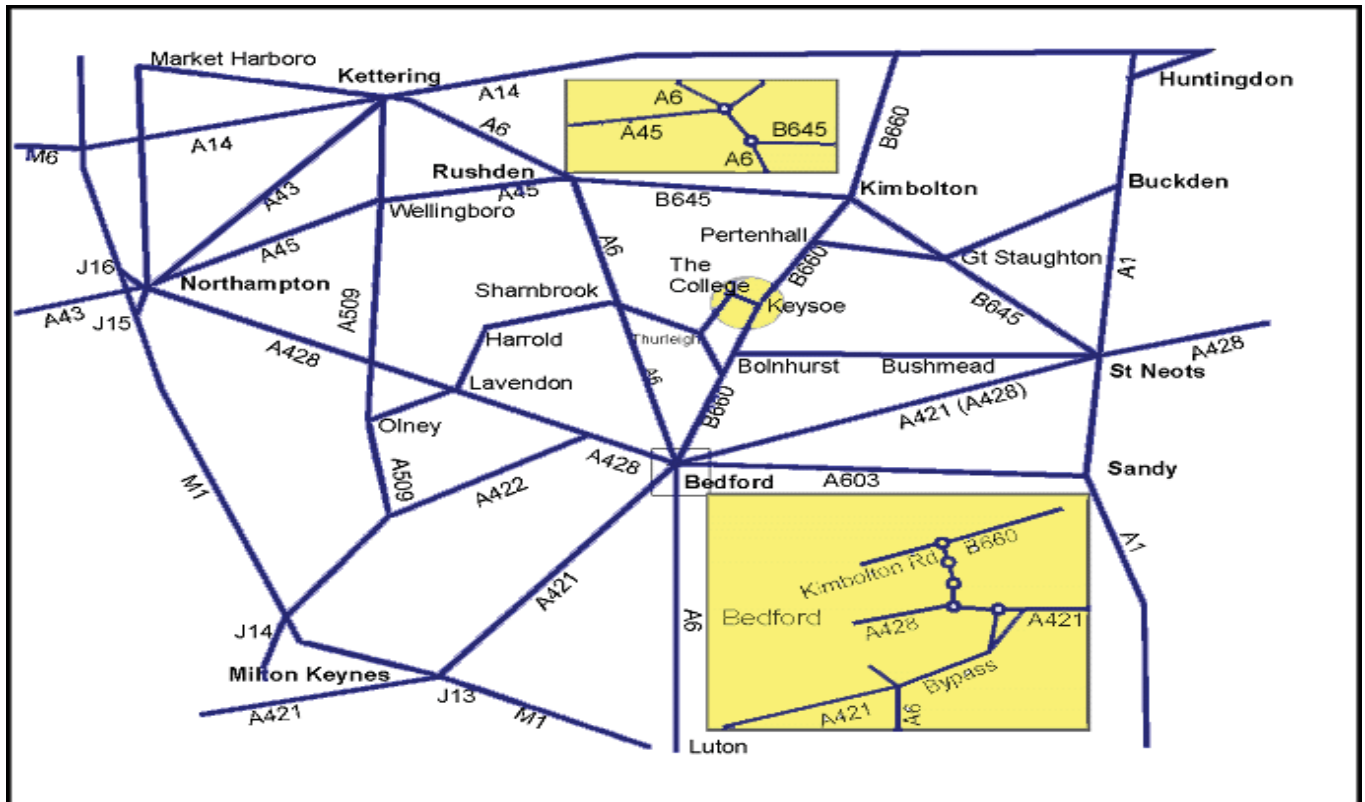
**Class 46 AMATEUR RIDDEN NATIVE / TRADITIONAL COB** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height. To be shown in a natural state. Open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders / horses / ponies, livery, buying, selling or dealing in horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 43-46 to compete.

## Rules & Regulations

1. All bookings of the Centre, once confirmed, are liable to a 50% cancellation fee should they be moved or cancelled. Cancellation of a full day without 3 months written notice, or a part day without a week's notice will make the total fee due.
2. The College EC reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the Competitions as they see fit due to weather conditions etc.
3. The ability to tie up horses to the outside of boxes is a privilege not a right. This practice WILL BE BANNED if horses continue to be left unattended, or are allowed to dig up the lorry park surface. No horses to be tied to buildings or fencing. No haynets outside horseboxes
4. Once an entry has been made, withdrawal will entail forfeiture of that fee. Fees will be liable immediately for any telephone / fax or e-mailed entry made after the closing date. Non declaration does not remove the requirement to pay the entry fee due
5. All unaffiliated events are run under the guidance of affiliated rules-BSJA, BD, or BE.
6. The decision of the judge is final.
7. Neither The College Equestrian Centre, nor any of its representative or staff shall be held liable for any accident, injury or damage or loss whatsoever, howsoever caused to any person animal or property at any time.
8. Please dispose of your litter thoughtfully in bins provided.
9. Please do not muck out into car parks.
10. Please ask organizers before riding on grass. Any lungeing is by prior permission only, and is never permitted indoors or outdoors. You are politely requested to pick up all droppings on arenas after your animal. Any damage to any property owned or hired or rented by or from The College EC apart from normal wear and tear will be paid for at cost at the time of damage
11. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas, and prohibited around the stable block or in arenas.
12. All dogs must be kept on leads. Dogs are not permitted on the veranda. If dog owners do not clean up their own dog's mess, this privilege will be removed. No dogs in arenas.
13. All horse and ponies must only move through areas shared with pedestrians at walk.
14. No competitor / rider shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure competitors, officials or other members of the public are not put at risk of injury
15. The College EC reserves the right to refuse entry to class and show ground.
16. Children must be under adult supervision at all times
17. Correctly secured Skull Caps / Riding Hats Nos: PAS 1998 & 2011 with kitemark, VGI with kitemark ASTM, F1163 04a onwards with SEI mark, SNELL E2001, Australian & New Zealand 3838 2003 onwards MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted.
18. The College EC reserves the right to restrict prizes to one for every five entries, in accordance with BSJA Rule 76 (6)
19. Formal objections must be made within 30 minutes of event, accompanied by a deposit of £25, forfeited if the objection is over ruled. Constructive criticism is welcomed.
20. Entry constitutes an agreement to be bound by and abide by these Rules.
21. We required payment in advance for each clinic (this minimizes our administration costs and therefore clinic prices). No space will be held without appropriate fee Payment will only be refunded on production of a Vet / Doctors certificate, providing reasonable notice is given, and the place can be re-allocated. If a clinic place cannot be re-allocated, payment in full must be made. Total fee can be transferred (once) to another clinic. No monies will be refunded for cancellations within 48 hrs of event. Every effort will be made to offer your place if a waiting list exists
22. Clinic times will be available 48 hours before the clinic by calling 01234 708400.
23. Please make cheques payable to "The College EC", or call with credit card details
24. Only riders, who have paid to enter a competition/clinic on that day may ride on the property owned by The College EC, unless permission is previously requested. The competition number worn must be applicable to the rider/horse combination that has paid an entry fee.

## MAIN ROUTES & DIRECTIONS TO THE COLLEGE



### From the North

**M1** - Exit J15 for Northampton (A508) this road becomes the A45, go past Wellingborough & Rushden, at the A45/A6 Roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit, next roundabout turn right onto B645 to Kimbolton. Just after Kimbolton turn right on to B660. Keysoe is 5 miles

**A1** - Turn off right at Buckden roundabout, past Grafham Water to Great Staughton. Turn right (B645 Kimbolton) After Stonely turn left (B660 Pertenhall & Keysoe) Keysoe is 5 miles.

### From The South

**M1** - Exit J13 for Bedford (A421), continue past Bedford on the bypass to exit A428 Bedford / Renhold / Barford. Take the A428 for Bedford, next roundabout, right (by Rogers) over 3 roundabouts, at 3<sup>rd</sup> (Pheasant Pub) turn right (B660) Keysoe is 8 miles

**A1** - Turn off left at second St Neots Exit (B645) Take the B645 Through Great Staughton & Stonely. Just before Kimbolton turn left onto B660 (Pertenhall & Keysoe), Keysoe is 5 miles

### From The West

**M6** then A14 turn off at Kettering for A6 (Rushden / Bedford), this is the 4<sup>th</sup> Kettering exit. Take the A6 to Rushden, after the A45 roundabout follow the Rushden bypass to pick up the B645 to Kimbolton, go through Kimbolton then right to pick up B660 (right turn) to Keysoe

**A43** to Northampton, then A45 (then as above M1 North)

**A421** across M1 to Bedford (then as "M1 South")

### From The East

**A428** to St Neots, follow signs to A1. Travel North on A1 for 1 mile, exit B645 (Kimbolton). Through Great Staughton, after Stonely turn left (B660 Keysoe).

**A14** to A1, South to Buckden (then as "A1 North")

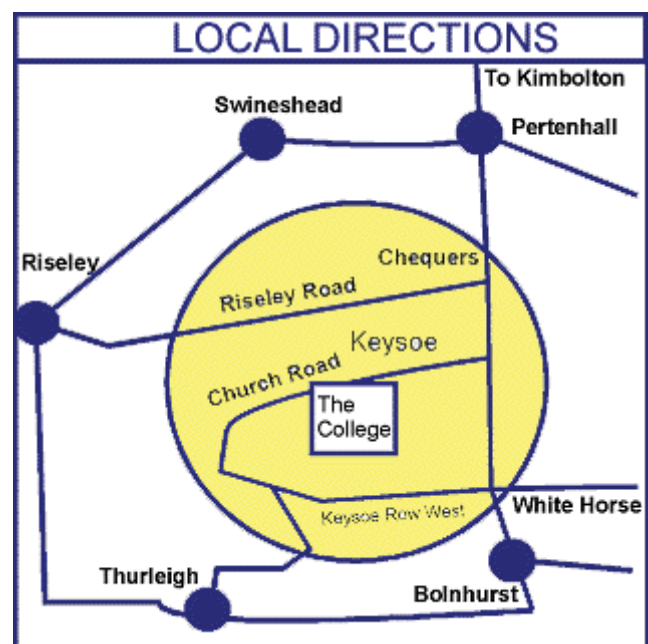
### Directions In Keysoe

**From the North** (Kimbolton / Pertenhall)

One mile past the Chequers Public house, (at the top of the hill) turn right into Church road, we are 3/4 mile on the left.

**From the South** (Bedford / Bolnhurst)

One mile past Kymbrook School / Keysoe Row junction, turn left into Church Road, we are 3/4 mile on the left
