RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Each class will consist of a course of show jumps followed immediately by portable simulated XC fences with a water splash. SJ & XC penalties will be added together, the course will be timed and scored against a disclosed Optimum Time (OT) and penalty scores allocated. OT for Class 1 & 2 based on 325mpm, Class 2 & 3 375mpm. Full rules – www.pcuk.org
- XC tack & colours should be worn in accordance with PC Eventing rules.
- Stopwatches are not permitted.
- Warm-up and the competition itself will take place on all-weather surfaces.
- Riders can only compete in two classes. Horses/ponies can only compete once in each class and only 2 classes.
- Horses/ponies must be 5 yrs old & over.
- No Supporters will be allowed in the warm-up areas.
- All competitors' hats must be appropriately tagged and body protectors must be worn complying with Pony Club 2019 rules and Pony Club Eventing 2019 rules apply if competing for a Pony Club Branch or Centre
- No ponies/horses should be left unattended or left tied to the outside of a lorry/trailer
- Vaccination rules apply www.pcuk.org/about-us/policies/ passports should be available for random checks.
- The Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be lodged with the Secretary with a £20 deposit within 15 minutes of class closing/results issued. Deposit will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- Health & Safety: the organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and

stewards.

- Disclaimer of liability: save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event of the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies nor the landlord or his tenant, accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, car their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry and to alter the programme as weather or any other conditions requires.
- Withdrawals will only be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser with a valid Vets certificate/Doctors note.
- If the event is cancelled due to Government, Local Authority or Pony Club restrictions, entry fees will be refunded in full.

COVID GUIDELINES

- If anyone attending the event breaches these guidelines, they will be asked to leave site immediately.
- Do not attend the event if you, anyone from your household or anyone you have been in close contact with have symptoms of Covid.
- Participants should only travel to the event with members of their own household.
- Each rider under 18yrs may bring 2 Adult Supporters to include the driver. Adult riders should only bring 1 Adult Supporter.
- Track & trace details will be recorded at the entry gate.
