Qualifying period: Second Rounds to be held at the 128cm/138cm Pony Premier Shows.

Numbers to qualify: *Three Pony/Rider combinations on day one and two Pony/Rider combinations on day two of the schedule, disregarding those already qualified and ponies ridden by riders who have already qualified two ponies. *Subject to change*.

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after the 1st of January 2008. Pony/Rider combinations that have qualified for Horse of the Year Show (HOYS) or Royal International Horse Show are not eligible to compete. 10 Year and under competitors to be born in or after the 1st of January 2009.

Table A (Both parts not against the clock). Maximum height of fences in the First Round 0.90m

All entrants must state year of birth on the entry form. Class will be DRAWN ORDER With 10 Years and under Style and Performance competitors going first.

11 and under section: Two double clears rounds needed, competitors may ride a maximum of two ponies in the Final.

10 and under section: Three Pony/Rider Combinations, disregarding those already qualified, to qualify for the British Showjumping 10 Years and Under Style & Performance Final. (Riders may only ride one pony in the Final). In the event of equality prize money is divided.
