Class 1 - 10:00 - International Ecotrack - Equissage Pulse Senior British Novice First Round

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members

a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2016 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round.

Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in the British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Lord & Lady Equestrian Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in a Lord & Lady Equestrian Senior Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2013, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money. Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification.

Those horses that have competed in the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2019 are not eligible for qualification to the 2020 Championship.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: National 1.40m Championship at the British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Also any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Senior British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings

for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2019 (assigned for the qualifying Period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2019 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Second Rounds

Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Second Round competition.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Second Round competition.

Qualifies for: 1.10m National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.10m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first, round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.10m Second Round competition.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Open to current registered British Showjumping Para Equestrians. Please ensure your compensating aid certificate is produced on entry to each class. Please note there will be one course walk for all grades before the start of the class.

All Para specific competitions are judged under Club rules but are open to both Club and National registered Para riders.

Points will be allocated to the British Showjumping Para Equestrian horse/rider combination league at Para competitions held from March 1st – August 31st 2020.

Points: 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3 DC = 3.

League winners for all grades will also be acknowledged during the League Presentation Ceremony at the British Showjumping Awards Ball in October.

N.B. Double points will be awarded at the RDA Championships and the British Showjumping National Championships. To qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships, you must have competed at one of the para show days earlier in the year as qualification.

A rider may only compete in their graded height unless they formally request in writing that they wish to jump up a grade. Should a rider request to jump up a grade they must continue to do so for all Para competitions outlined for the remainder of the year.

Points will be allocated to the British Showjumping Para Equestrian horse/rider combination league at Para competitions held from March 1st – August 31st 2020.

Points: 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3 DC = 3.

League winners for all grades will also be acknowledged during the League Presentation Ceremony at the British Showjumping Awards Ball in October.

N.B. Double points will be awarded at the RDA Championships and the British Showjumping National Championships. To qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships, you must have competed at one of the para show days earlier in the year as qualification.

A rider may only compete in their graded height unless they formally request in writing that they wish to jump up a grade. Should a rider request to jump up a grade they must continue to do so for all Para competitions outlined for the remainder of the year.

Class 17 - Clopf Arena - Para Equestrian Junior Grade I

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 60cm.

Open to current registered British Showjumping Para Equestrians. Please ensure your compensating aid certificate is produced on entry to each class. Please note there will be one course walk for all grades before the start of the class.

All Para specific competitions are judged under Club rules but are open to both Club and National registered Para riders.

Points will be allocated to the British Showjumping Para Equestrian horse/rider combination league at Para competitions held from March 1st – August 31st 2020.

Points: 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3 DC = 3.

League winners for all grades will also be acknowledged during the League Presentation Ceremony at the British Showjumping Awards Ball in October.
