### Single phase Competition Rules

Single Phase Competition Table A – both sections.

Faults to be accumulated over both sections.

First and Second section with a time allowed (no time faults on 45-65 cms classes) and time limit. Second section against the clock.

The competitor will jump the whole course unless they are eliminated.

Number of fences: Five to seven fences in each section (minimum 10 fences maximum 13 fences overall).

The height of the second section should be set higher than those set for the first section. – Except in 45 & 55 cms classes where both sections will be same height

## **Thursday Evening Clear Round Jumping outdoors – 16/04/20, 30/04/20, 14/05/20, 18/06/20**

5:00pm 60cms, 5:45pm 70cms, 7:00pm 80cms followed by 90cms & 1.00M

If you are ready to jump at those times you will not miss your height.
